

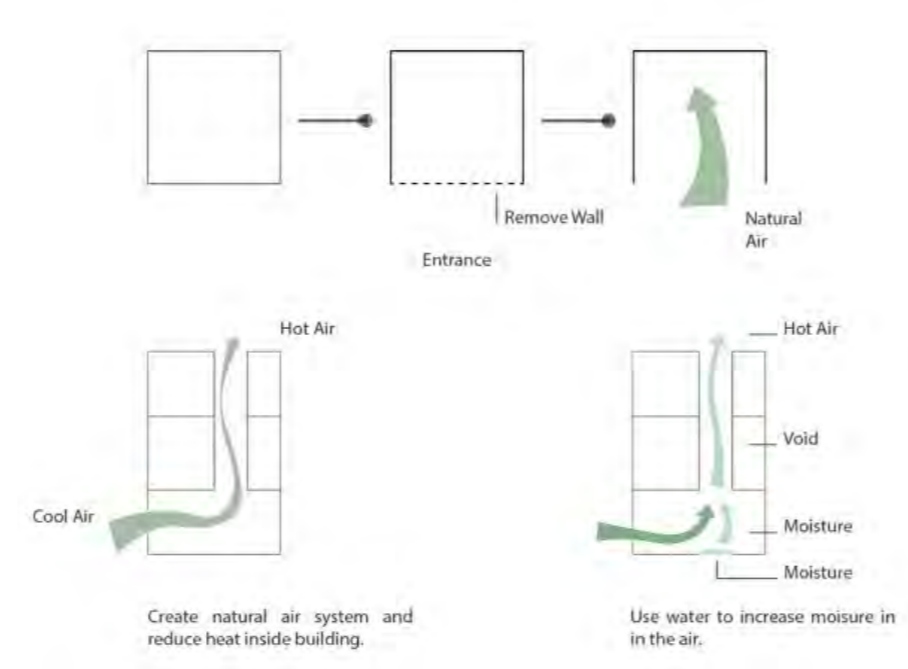
TOKYO ELDERLIES 2017 International Workshop towards Architecture and Urban Design for Asian Cities

The international workshops pursue visions of Asian cities in architecture and urbanism. King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi, Thailand (KMUTT) joined Shibaura Institute of Technology, Japan (SIT) Tokyo 2017 following Tokyo 2015 and Bangkok 2016 besides Seoul 2012 and Tokyo 2014 with Chung-ang University, and Johor Bahru 2015 and Tokyo 2016 with Universiti Teknologi Malaysia. SIT and KMUTT collaborated eight days on elderlies. The study site was Shirokanedai Iki-Iki Plaza and Jidokan, a public complex having served elderlies and kids nearly thirty years, run by Minato City, a Tokyo Metropolitan ward, that helped organize the workshop. 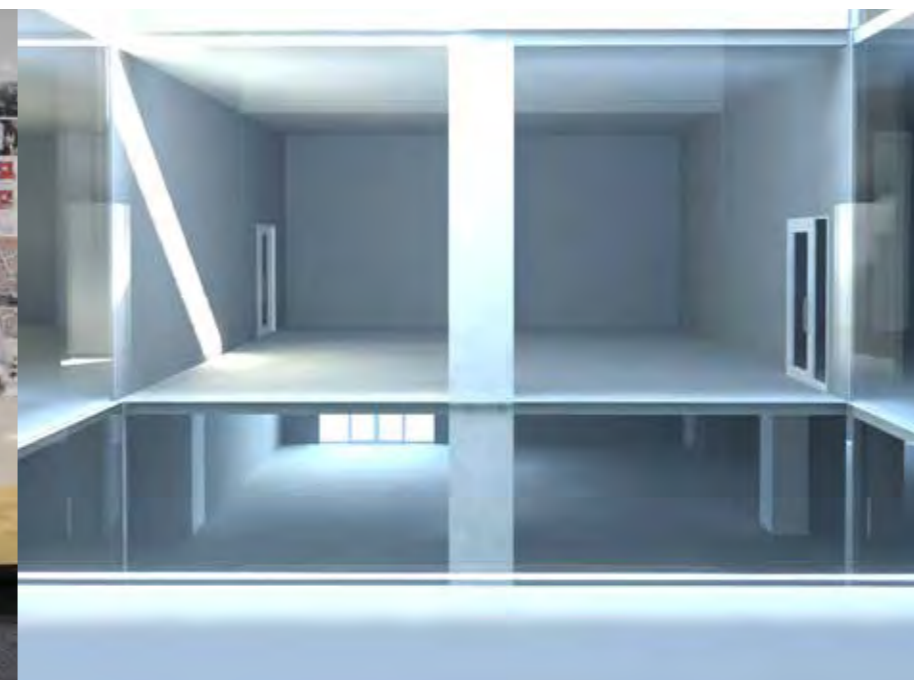

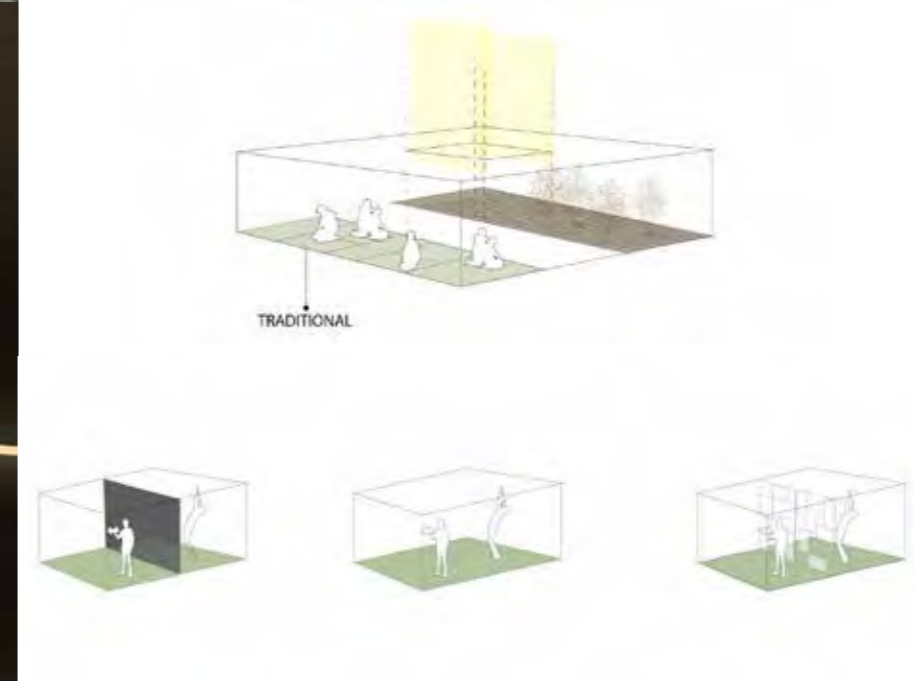
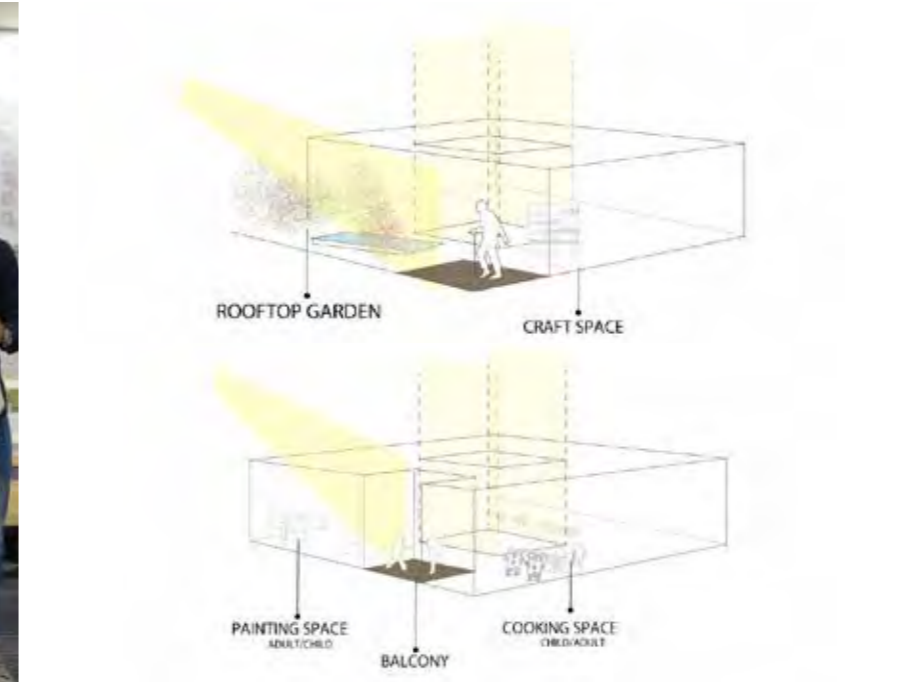
